INGREDIENTS:

Water, Enriched Elbow Macaroni (semolina [wheat], egg white, niacin, ferrous sulfate [iron], thiamin mononitrate, riboflavin, folic acid), Pasteurized Process Colored American Cheese (American cheese [milk, cheese culture, salt, enzymes], water, dry cream, milkfat, sodium phosphate, salt, lactic acid, sorbic acid [preservative], annatto and oleoresin paprika [color]), Pasteurized Processed Cheddar Cheese Spread (cheddar cheese [milk, cheese culture, salt, enzymes], water, whey, milkfat, whey protein concentrate, nonfat milk, sodium citrate, contains less than 2% of lactic acid, salt), Cheddar Cheese (pasteurized milk, cheese cultures, salt, enzymes), Nonfat Dry Milk, Modified Food Starch, Heavy Cream (cream, fat free milk), Salt, Sodium Phosphate, Cheddar Cheese Flavor Base (cheddar cheese [milk, cultures, salt, enzymes], salt, yeast extract, corn oil, dry vegetable shortening, unsalted butter [cream, flavorings], sweet cream powder, sugar, dry mustard, disodium inosinate/disodium guanylate, potassium sorbate), Annatto Extract (water, natural extractives of annatto seed, potassium hydroxide), White Distilled Vinegar.

FROZEN HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS:

Hold at a frozen state 0-15°F until time of use. Thaw under refrigeration for approximately 24-36 hours at or below 40°F. Heat to 165°F as quickly as possible by placing pouches in a water bath, kept preferably around 180 -190°F or by pouring thawed product into double boiler (stirring constantly to avoid scalding).
